

## ***Toronto Life* wins highest combined total of gold and silver awards at the 32<sup>nd</sup> annual National Magazine Awards**

**Toronto, Ontario (June 8, 2009)** – Taking home four gold and five silver awards, *Toronto Life* won the highest combined total of awards at this year's National Magazine Awards held in Toronto on June 5, 2009.

Recognized for both design and editorial, *Toronto Life* won gold in the Magazine Covers category for its August 2008 story, "How the Gun has Changed Toronto," and in the Editorial Packaging for a Single Service Article category for its October 2008 feature, "Best of Fall." *Toronto Life* also received gold in the Arts & Entertainment category for its article "The Curse of the Aluminum Crystal" and in the Profiles category for "The Prophet," a portrait of Moses Znaimer.

*Toronto Life's* silver wins were in the categories for Best Short Feature, Columns, Profiles, Art Direction for a Single Magazine Article and Portrait Photography. *Toronto Life* also earned 17 honourable mentions.

Other St. Joseph Media titles recognized at the 32<sup>nd</sup> annual National Magazine Awards include *FASHION Magazine* and *Ottawa Magazine*, each with two honourable mentions.

The National Magazine Awards Foundation received more than 2,000 individual entries nationwide for this year's awards. Judges nominated a total of 341 submissions in 79 different Canadian magazines for awards in 36 categories
